Application deadline: October 30, 2009 2010 Horatio Alger Scholarship seeks to assist students who have demonstrated integrity, perseverance in overcoming adversity, strength of character, financial need, a good academic record, commitment to pursue a college education, and a desire to contribute to society. Applicants must be a full time high school senior with plans to enter college in the fall, intend to pursue a bachelor's degree at an accredited institution, must have critical financial need (\$50,000 or less adjusted income), involvement in co-curricular and community activities, a minimum 2.0 GPA, and a US citizen.
